

# The Eucharist

## Priest's Part

## MUSIC FOR THE PRIEST'S PART OF THE HOLY EUCHARIST

During the approach to the Altar the Introit may be sung (See p. xlix. in The Book of Common Prayer). The Gloria Patri is used except in Passiontide and a verse may be repeated as an antiphon.

The Lord's Prayer, The Collect for Purity, and the Commandments or Summary of the Law should always be said.

The response to the Commandments may be sung.

The Salutation may be sung.

The Collect may be intoned or sung. If sung, the full close is used at the end of the address and again at the end of the doxology. The half close occurs at the end of the petition and also of the oblation.

Eg. Almighty and Everlasting God, who dost govern all things in *heaven and earth*: (Full Close) Mercifully hear the supplications of thy people, and grant us thy peace all the days of our *life*; (Half Close) through Jesus Christ our *Lord*, (Half Close) Who liveth and reigneth with thee and the Holy Ghost, ever one God, *world without end*. (Full Close)

The first and last inflections are full even when the Collect does not have all four parts, except that the full close is not used twice in sequence.

Sung or intoned prayers have sung 'Amens'. Said prayers should always have said 'Amens'.

Graduals are appointed from the Psalms (See p. xlix. in The Book of Common Prayer). The Gloria is not used but in certain seasons "Alleluia" may be added.

The Creed may be sung. The Priest presents "I believe in one God," the congregation joining at the words, "the Father Almighty. . . ."

The Prayer for the Church, Exhortation, Confession, Absolution and the Comfortable Words should always be said.

The Salutation, Sursum Corda, Preface, Sanctus and Benedictus may be sung.

The Pax may be sung.

The Agnus Dei may be sung.

The Lord's Prayer may be sung and the Prayer of Thanksgiving may be inflected in the same manner as the Collect.

The Gloria in Excelsis may be sung, the Priest presenting the words, "Glory be to God on High" and the people joining at the words, "and on earth peace. . . ."

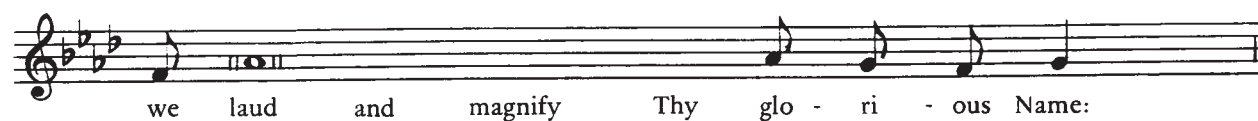
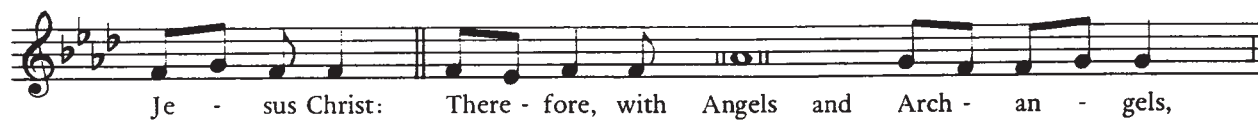
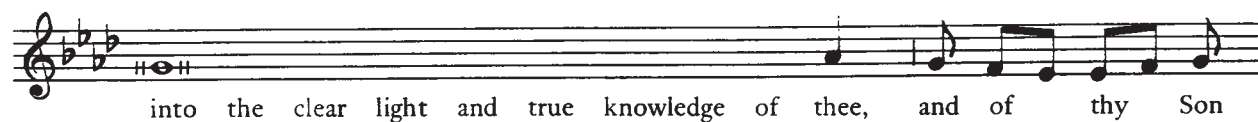
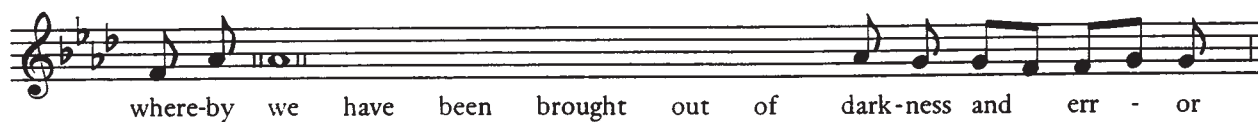


# ASCENSION TO EVE OF WHIT SUNDAY
